- Before Reading:

Take a picture walk through the book. Let your child tell you about the pictures on each page or even ask you questions about the pictures.

- Ask

- What is the author's job? What is the illustrator's job?
- What story clues are in the title and the pictures?
- Is this fiction or nonfiction? How do you know?

- Read the book together. After Reading:

- Ask

- Who was in the story (characters)?
- Where did the story take place (setting)?
- Tell me what happened at the beginning of the story? Next? At the end?

- Complete the main idea and details page. Read and discuss the main idea in the center circle with your child. Then, have him/her draw and label four hats from the book (details that support the main idea).

***Math**

_____ Play the board game, "Race to the Moon": Each player needs 20 counters (use beans, pennies, etc...)

1. Choose an addition problem on the left side of the board. Say the problem and answer.
2. If you are correct, you place a counter on that space (only 1 counter can be on a space).
3. Now it is your partner's turn.
4. The winner is the first person to complete an unbroken path of counters from Earth to the moon (the path can go across, down, and diagonally).

Variation: If you get an answer wrong, your partner can remove one of your counters from the board.
